

SCHOOL INFORMATION FOR THE 2023/2024 SCHOOL YEAR

School Begins: Thursday, September 7, 2023

School Ends: Friday, June 21, 2024

Office and School Hours:

Office Hours: Mon -Thurs 7:45 am to 4:00 pm; Fridays 7:45 am to 3:00 pm

School Hours: 1st - 10th: 8:00 am to 3:00 pm

Kindergarten Hours: 8:00 am to 2:00 pm

Minimum School Day Hours (every Friday): 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. Extended daycare is provided in the mornings from 6:00 am to 7:45 am. Afternoon daycare hours are 12:15 pm to 6:00 pm.

Requirements:

- *Kindergarten students must be 5 years old by September 1, 2023.*
- *1st grade students must be 6 years old by September 1, 2023, and have a current physical exam.*
- *An adolescent whooping cough booster immunization (Tdap) is required for students entering 7th grade in September 2023. (New and returning students).*
- *A placement test will be scheduled for all new enrollees for Grades 1st – 10th. There is a \$30 (cash or check) fee due at the time of testing. This fee is not part of registration.*
- *You will receive a phone call approximately one week after testing with placement results. If the student is accepted into our school, you may continue with the process below.*

Early Registration Dates and Discount for the 2023/2024 school year.

Dates: Monday, March 6, 2023, through Friday, June 2, 2023

Discounted Registration: \$120 (Non-refundable) per student. After June 2, 2023, Registration: \$175 per student

Tuition is calculated based on the entire school year; therefore, NO deductions are made for school vacations, school holidays, or a student's absence during the school year.

Tuition and Fees for Grades K through 8th:

Option 1 – \$5,565/year or \$556.30/month for 10 months. The monthly payment plan allows ten (10) equal monthly payments totaling the complete amount of the tuition to be paid beginning **September 19th**, with consecutive payments due on the 19th of each month. If the account is not paid by **the 26th** of each month, a **\$30 late fee** will be charged to the student's account.

Option 2 – 5,565/year or \$463.75/month for 12 months. This option is only available if student is registered by July, 2023. The monthly payment plan allows twelve (12) equal monthly payments totaling the complete amount of the tuition to be paid beginning **July 19th**, with consecutive payments due on the 19th of each month. If the account is not paid by the **26th** of each month, a **\$30 late fee** will be charged to the student's account.

Family Discount Rates for Grades K through 8th. Full tuition is charged from the oldest to the youngest child.

2nd Child ~ \$4,618.95 (\$461.90/month for 10 months)

3rd Child ~ \$4340.70 (\$434.07/month for 10 months)

4th Child or more ~ Free

5th Child ~ \$4118.10 (\$411.81/month for 10 months)

Tuition and Fees for Grades 9th and 10th:

Option 1 – \$6,300/year or \$630/month for 10 months. (See above for monthly payment dates and late fees).

Option 2 – \$6,300/year or \$525/month for 12 months (*This option is only available for students registered by July, 2023.*)

Family Discount Rates for Grades 9th and 10th. Full tuition is charged from the oldest to the youngest child.

2nd Child ~ \$5229 (\$522.90/month for 10 months)

3rd Child ~ \$4914 (\$491.30/month for 10 months)

Returning Students:

All accounts must be current to re-enroll for the 2023/2024 school year or your re-enrollment will not be processed. Accounts with a history of past due payments will be reviewed and will be required to have three (3) months of on time payments prior to enrollment.

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Textbook Fees and Other Information

Current Textbook Pricing: Book fees are non-refundable. Prices are subject to change without notice; prices reflect 2022/2023 school year and will change based on publisher's new fees for the 2023/2024 school year.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Any student who does not have textbooks in hand by the first day of school, Thursday, September 7, 2023, may be charged a fee of \$15.00 per day to cover the cost of photocopying textbook pages. This will be determined by administration on a case-by-case basis.

Bob Jones University Press (BJU) 5th through 10th GRADE:

Parent Ordering Textbook: All textbooks must be ORDERED BY THE PARENT through Bob Jones University Press. Textbooks will be delivered to your home. (*Tests and quizzes will be ordered by the school office.*) Using the search bar, go to bjupress.com/go/parentportal to purchase your student's textbooks no later than August 1, 2023. See the school office for detailed instructions.

Test and Quizzes (BJU): \$20 per student. Book fees, tests, and quizzes are non-refundable.

The fees will be billed monthly. If your child will not be having pizza, we will credit your account accordingly. You must notify the school no later than 11:00 am, on the Wednesday prior to those Pizza Thursdays.

Extended Daycare Fees: Extended daycare is available for K – 10th grade students from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Daycare families are billed monthly: \$5.00 per hour for the first child and \$4.00 per hour for each additional child.

Extended Daycare Hours:

Morning daycare is charged from 6:00 am to 7:45 am. Afternoon daycare hours for Kindergarten are 2:15 pm to 6:00 pm, with charges beginning at 2:15 pm. Afternoon daycare hours, for grades 1st – 10th are 3:15 pm to 6:00 pm, with charges beginning at 3:15 pm. *At 2:15 pm and 3:15 pm, all remaining students will automatically go into daycare.*

When a student is picked up from daycare, a parent or an adult designated by the parent on the authorization form must sign out the student in the Daycare Logbook. Photo ID may be required. Using daycare is a privilege, not a right. Students who are not respectful and/or obedient may be denied the privilege of daycare.

Any student left from 6:00 pm - 6:15 pm, and on minimum days from 2:00 pm - 2:15 pm will be charged a \$30 late fee and a \$1.00 per minute thereafter (per student). Students picked up late more than twice in a semester may result in losing daycare privileges for the remainder of the school year. This will be at the discretion of administration.

Miscellaneous Fees: Parents should anticipate additional costs including but not limited to special books, instructional supplies, field trips, student portraits, class pictures, graduation, and special events - music, culinary arts, drama productions, and assemblies.

Tuition: Failure to submit tuition payment within 20 days of the due date may result in the school withdrawing the student from all classes until payment is made. Students suspended from school due to a delinquent account are permitted to make-up missed schoolwork.

Check Policy: There will be a \$30 charge assessed to your account for each check returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF). After two NSF checks, only cash, cashier's check, money order and credit card (online through Gradelink) will be accepted for payment.

Food Services: Students need to bring their lunch daily, except for Thursdays. Students have the option to participate in Pizza Thursdays, for a nominal fee.

Parent/Teacher Contact: Parents are encouraged to communicate with the school and/or their student's teacher as the need arises. Parents can write a note to the teacher, call the school office to arrange a conference, or use the school's website (ccrschool.com) to contact a teacher by email. **Parents may not interrupt a class during school hours, but they may go through the school office to contact a student or teacher.**
